

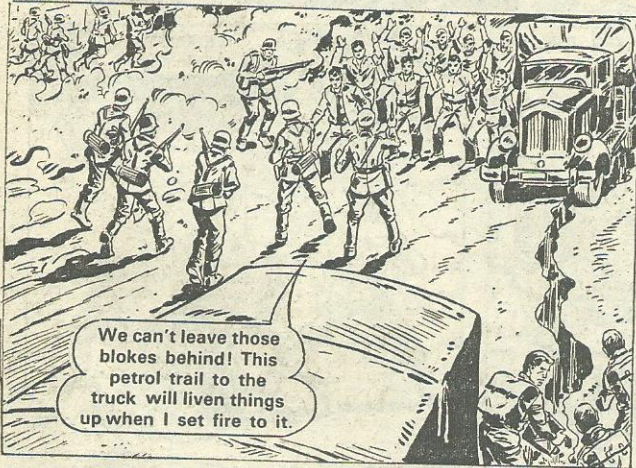
# THE BANG BOYS



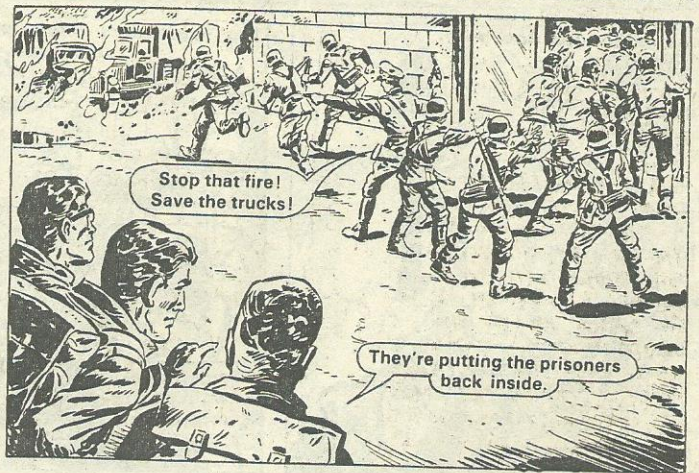
The Jerries have lost their tower—but they've still got the prisoners!
