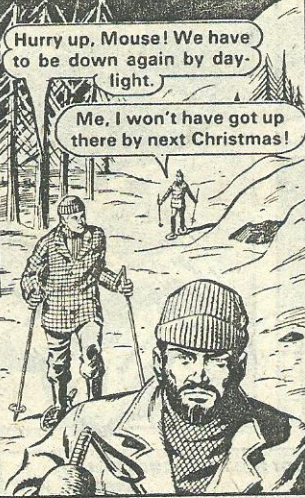
The ice was thick on a Norwegian fjord... except where a hole had been cut for the conning tower of a British submarine.



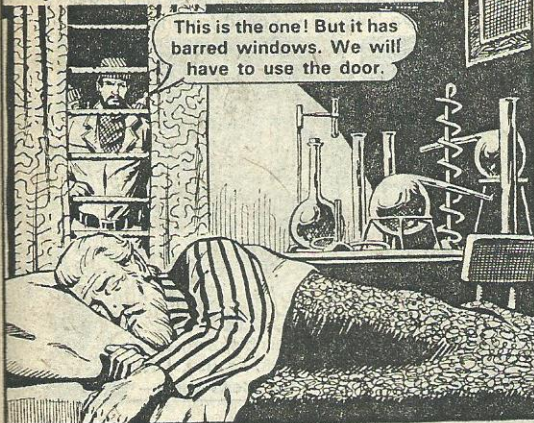
As arranged, Cat and Mouse met Einar Kirkefjord, a Norwegian resistance fighter.

They checked the hostel buildings, then...

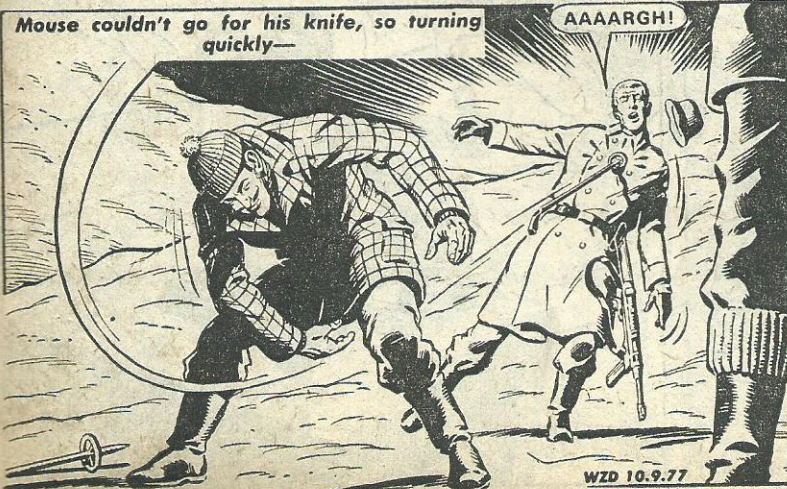


But—
