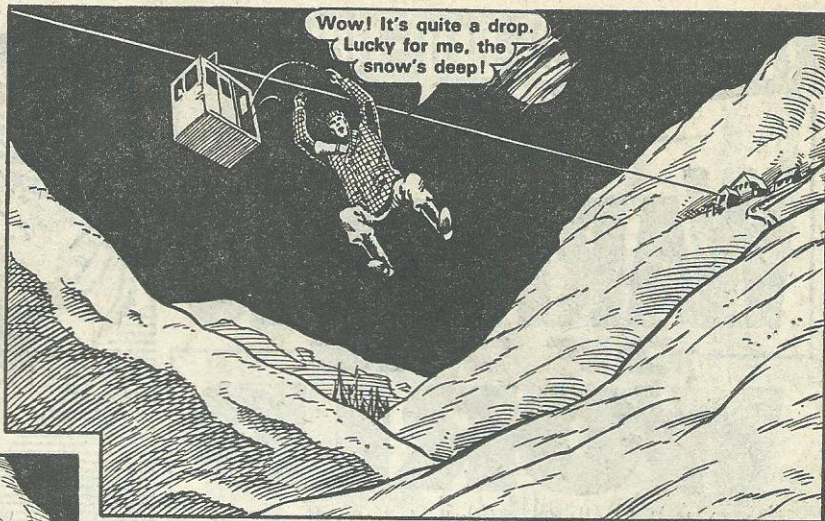




The car's coming to the bottom station. I'll have to get off—



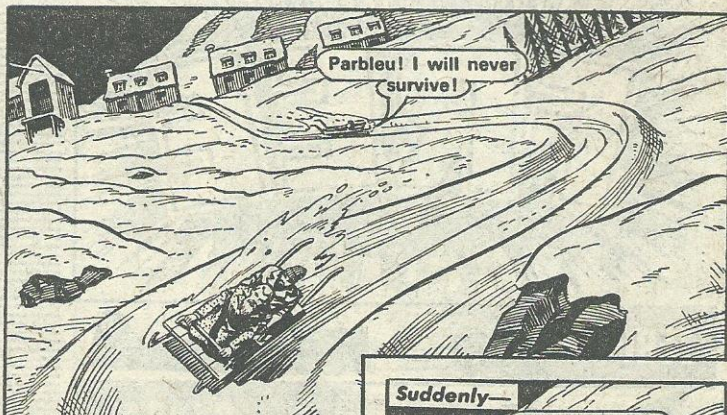
Wow! It's quite a drop. Lucky for me, the snow's deep!



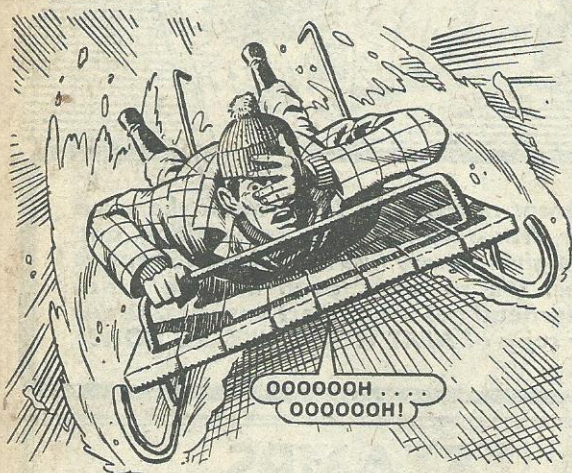
Meanwhile—

That German will not give the alarm now. Follow us down, Mouse . . .

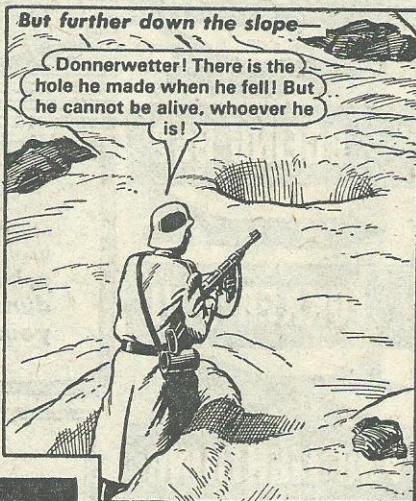
How? I mean, what do I do?

OOOOOOH!



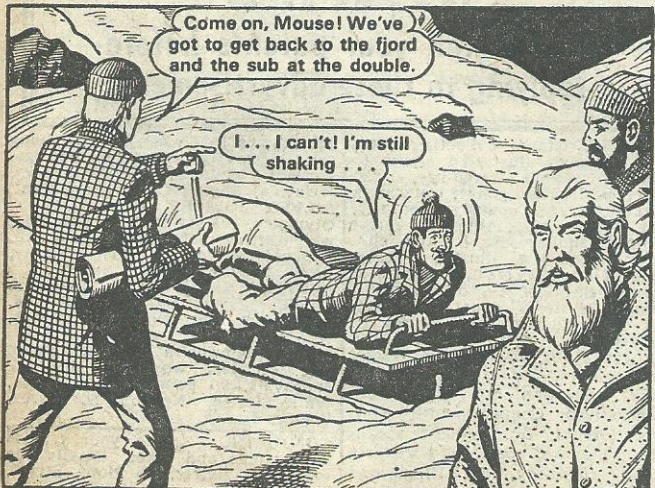
But further down the slope—
