

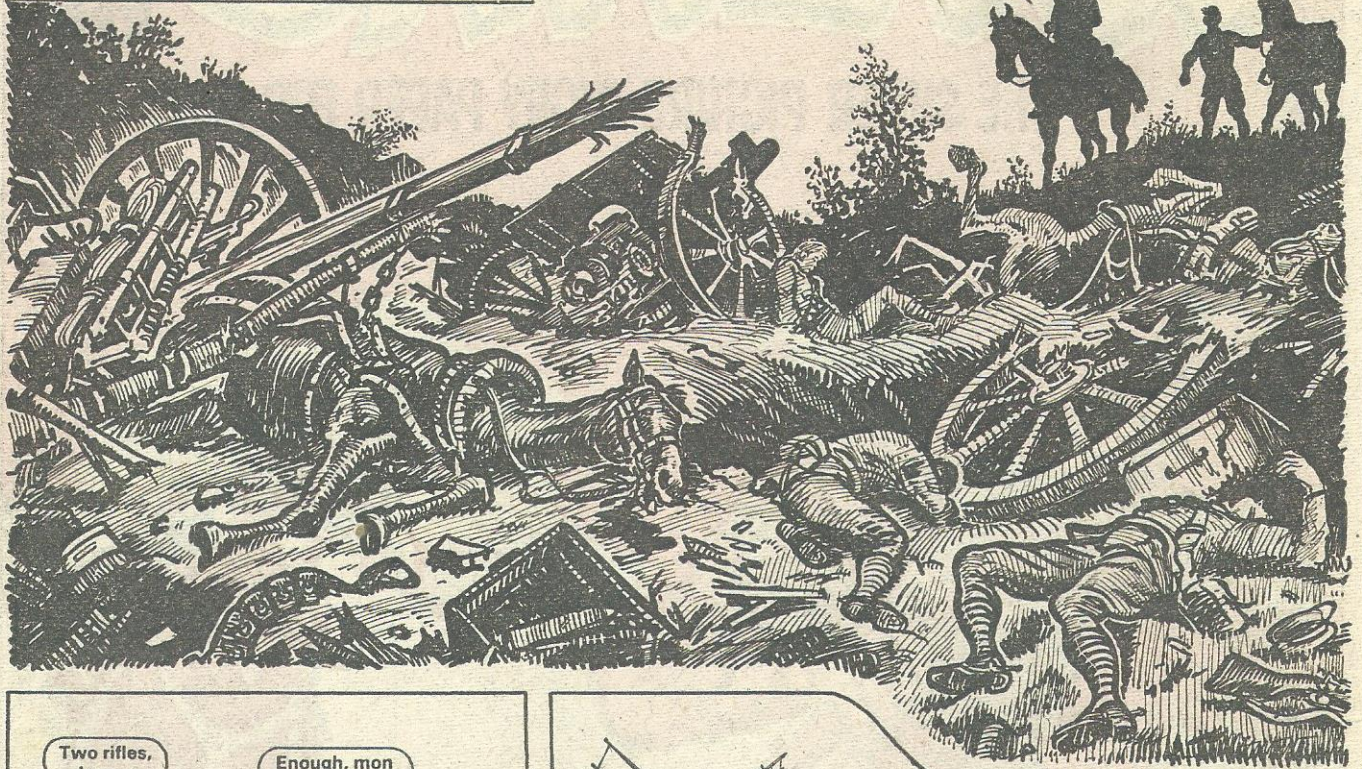
DUEL IN THE SKY!

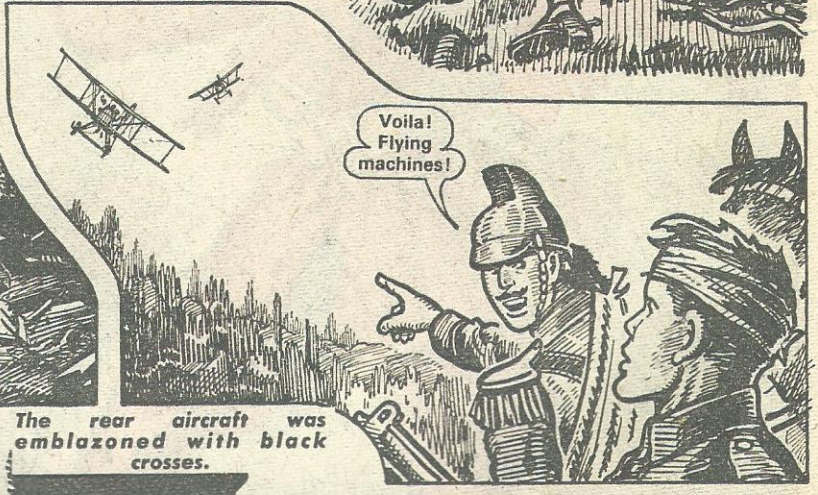
A retreating column mangled by Boche guns!

Enough, mon brave. Come back—hurry.

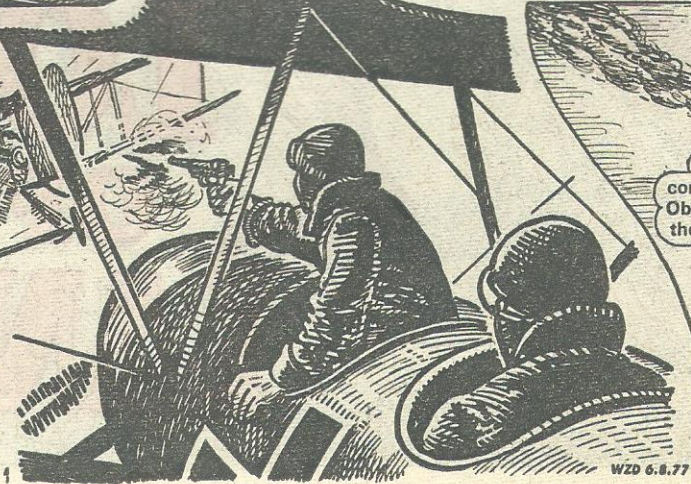


Voila! Flying machines!
