**Syd Bunt,** mechanic / Airfield Ops.

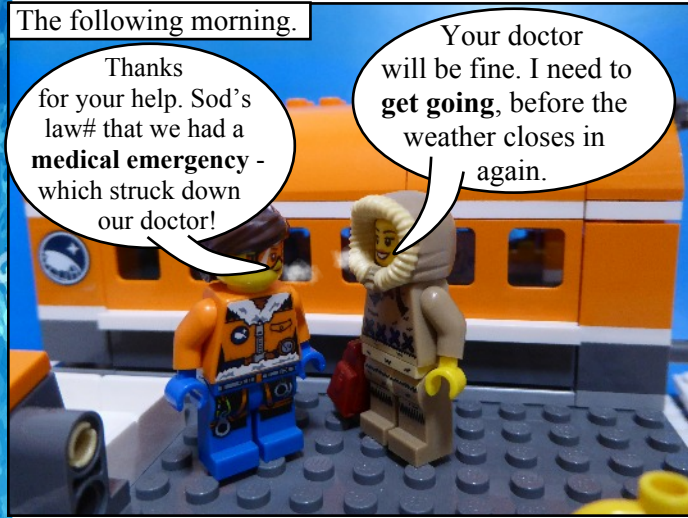
**Albert Copperwaite,** (The Guard). Handy man / Airfield Ops.
