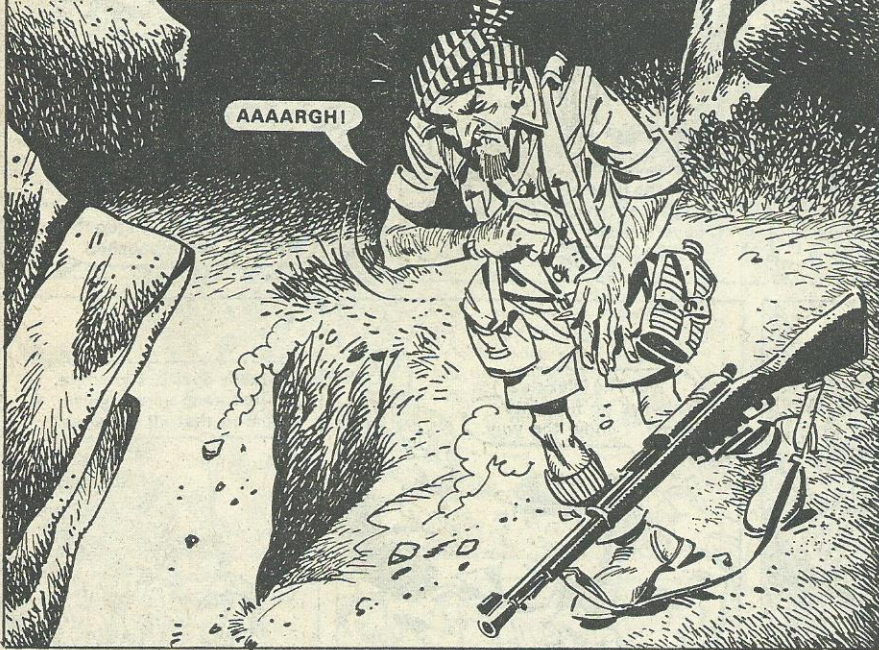


MULLIGAN
