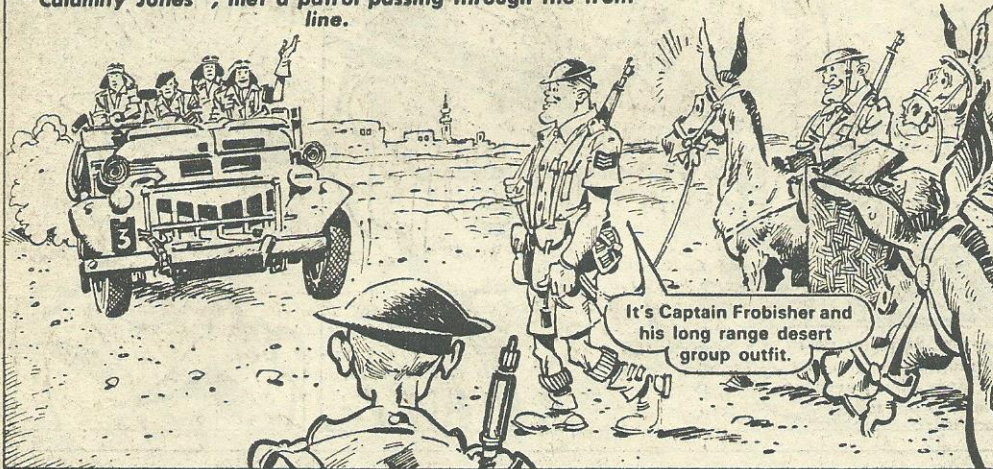


# MULLIGAN AND HIS MULES

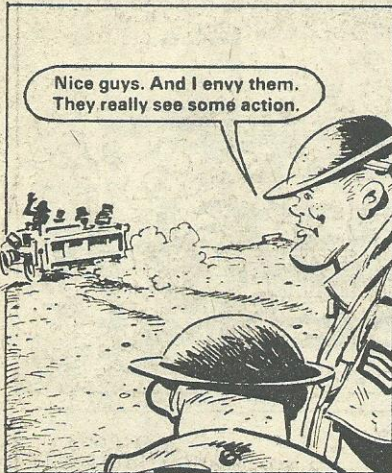


It's Captain Frobisher and his long range desert outfit.

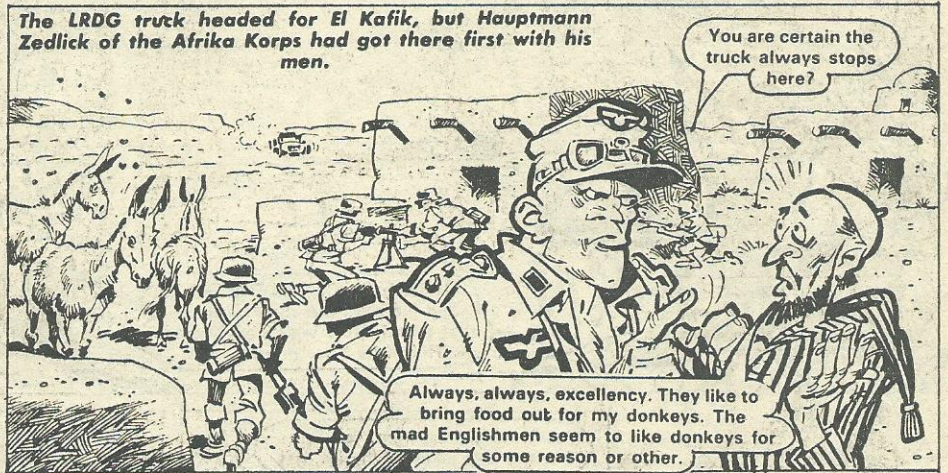


You spoil 'em, sir. Giving 'em sugar lumps every time you see 'em.

Nice guys. And I envy them. They really see some action.



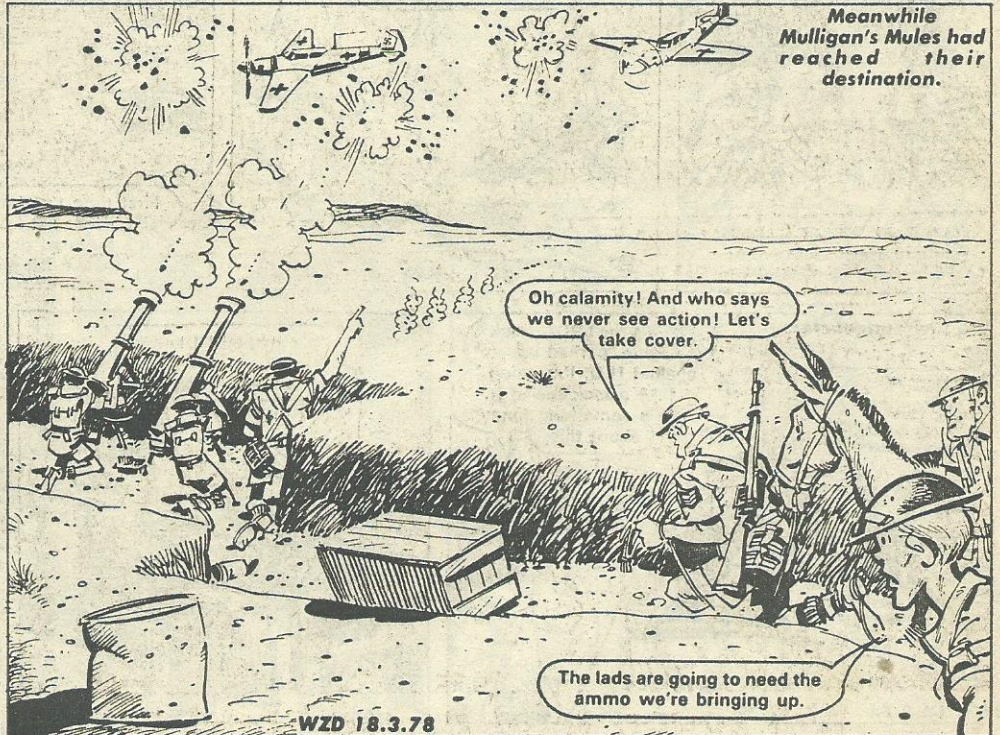
The LRDG truck headed for El Kafik, but Hauptmann Zedlick of the Afrika Korps had got there first with his men.
