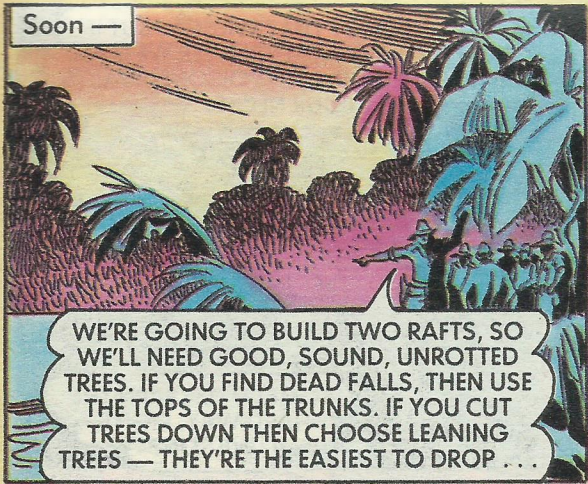


Soon —
