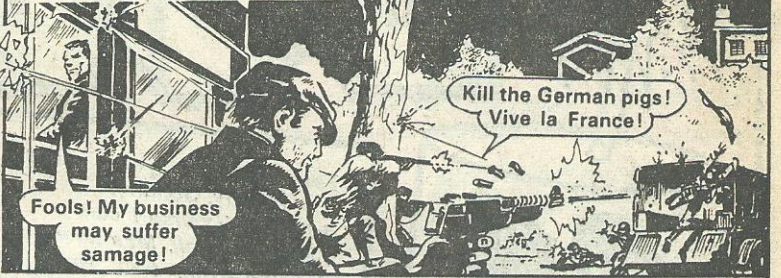


" He still prospered during the war when German troops occupied the village.

That night, Andre met a German officer.

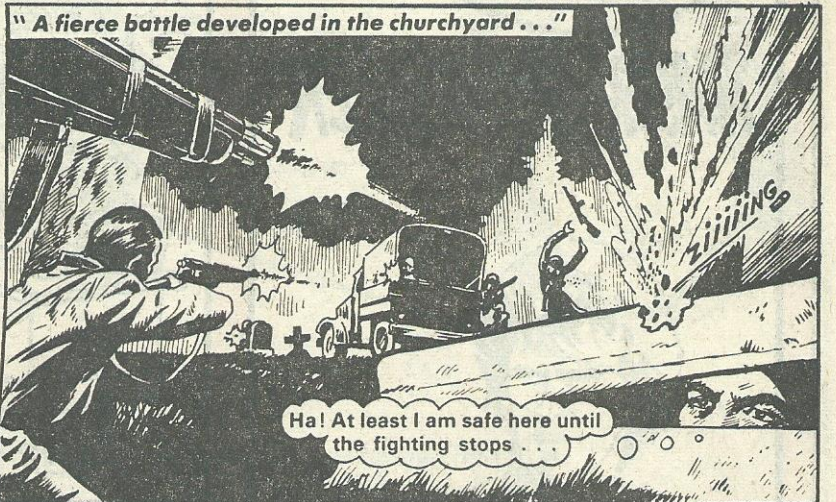
I know where the Resistance leaders sometimes meet. If I spy on them will you protect my business, Herr Major?

Of course! We Germans always look after our friends.



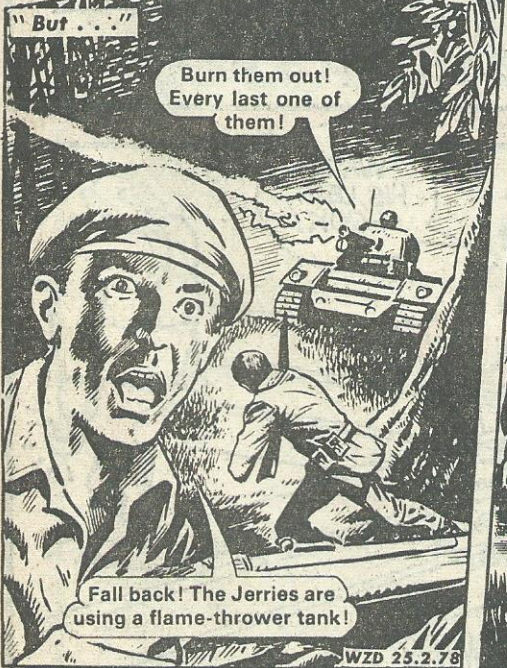
Look out! Boche patrol!
