I'M ALL RIGHT. SWING ME IN AGAINST THE FACE.

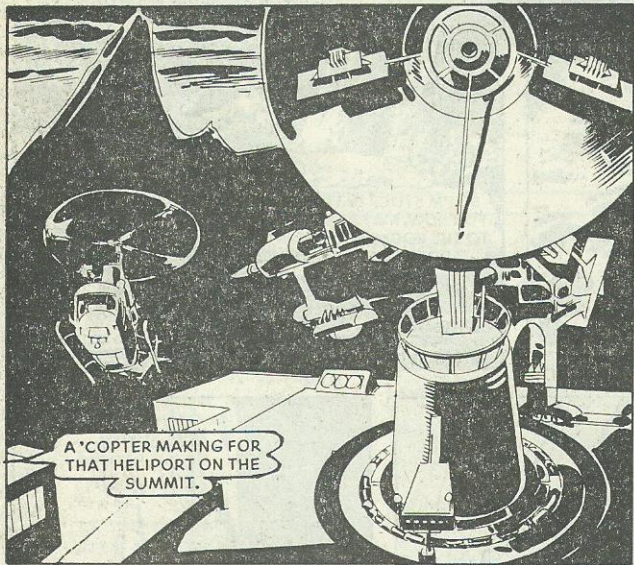


Tommy began to work his way back up the crag.

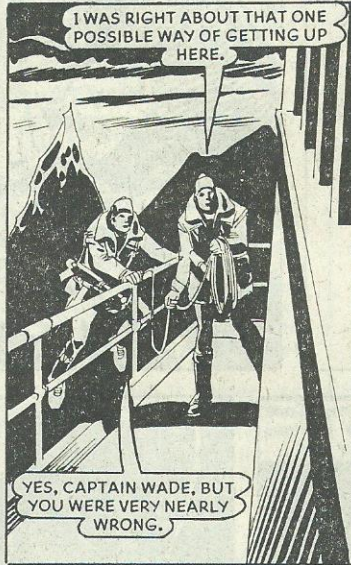


NOW I KNOW HOW A FLY FEELS ON A WINDOW.

A 'COPTER MAKING FOR THAT HELIPORT ON THE SUMMIT.

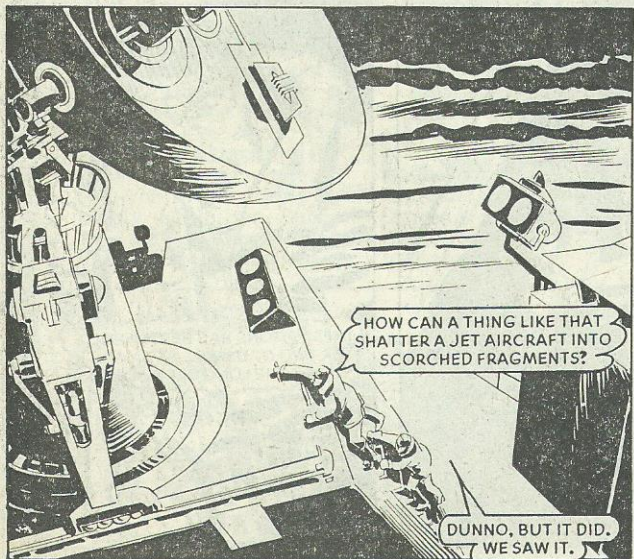


I WAS RIGHT ABOUT THAT ONE POSSIBLE WAY OF GETTING UP HERE.
