Just then Brigadier Burman appeared.

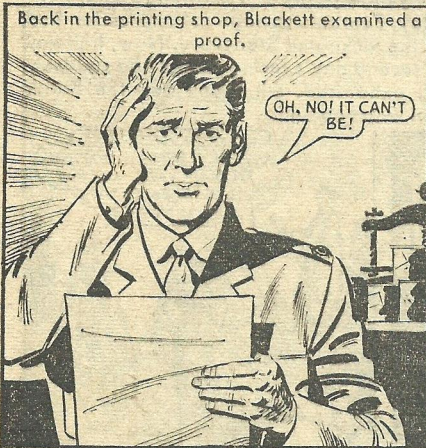
THIS LOOKS GOOD, I'LL TAKE A PROOF BACK TO H.Q. AND EXAMINE IT!

OH, NO! IT CAN'T BE!

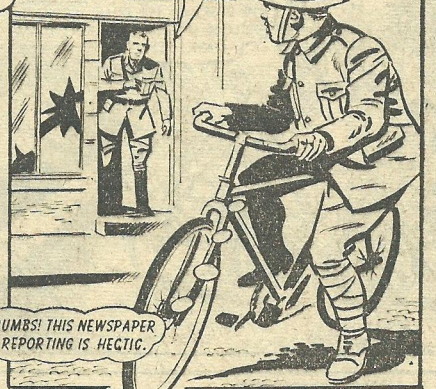

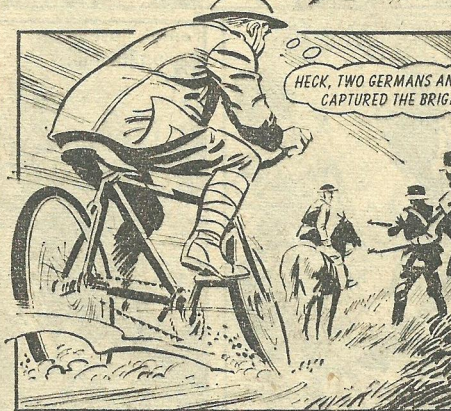

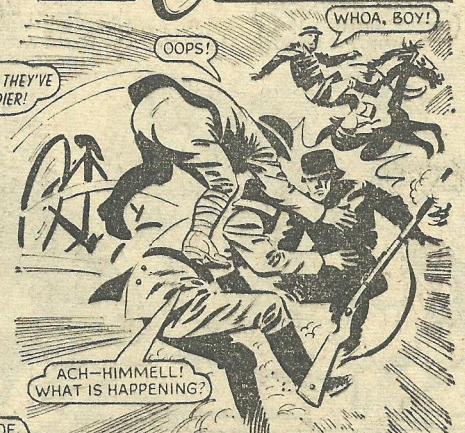
Meanwhile, on the road to H.Q..

SO, HANS—WE WILL CAPTURE HIM!



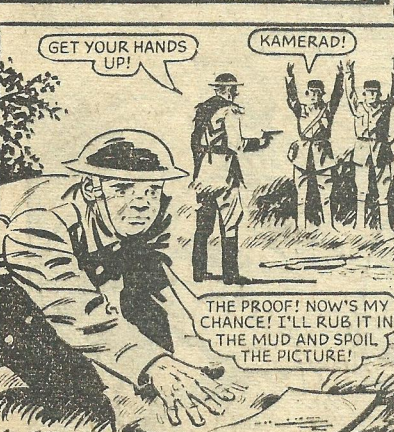
HECK, TWO GERMANS AND THEY'VE CAPTURED THE BRIGADIER!
